Things to Do

"Explore Our Stories" Photo Exhibit

Located on level M of Canada Place near the FlyOver entrance, this Parks Canada and Canadian Heritage collaboration features images from every province and territory, showcasing Canada's national parks, historic sites, and marine conservation areas.

"Salish Sea, the Journey Within"

Visitors to the Canadian Trail are greeted by this Coast Salish artwork designed by Susan Point and her sons. The piece reflects traditional motifs and celebrates the enduring presence of Coast Salish Peoples, welcoming all who arrive at the Salish Sea.

2010 Olympic Legacy Display

At the Vancouver Convention Centre, see Olympic and Paralympic medals, torches, interpretive panels, and a medal podium from the 2010 Games. VCC's East building hosted the Main Press Centre and the West building the International Broadcast Centre.

BC Sports Hall of Fame and Museum

Founded in 1966, the BC Sports Hall of Fame and Museum honors the achievements of BC's top athletes, teams, and sport builders. With 452 individuals and 69 teams inducted to date, the Hall educates and inspires through exhibits and programs celebrating BC's rich sporting history. It is internationally recognized for its extensive artifact and archival collection, supporting research and storytelling by writers, media, and historians. Open Tuesday to Sunday, 10:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.

Bill Reid Gallery of Northwest Coast Art

Located downtown, this is Canada's only public gallery dedicated to contemporary Indigenous Northwest Coast art. It celebrates the life of Haida artist Bill Reid and showcases exhibitions that bridge Indigenous and settler perspectives.

Capilano Suspension Bridge Park

Home to a 450-foot-long suspension bridge and other aerial experiences like the Cliffwalk and

Treetops Adventure, this scenic park offers rainforest exploration above the Capilano River.

Chinese Canadian Museum

Housed in the historic Wing Sang Building in Chinatown, this museum highlights the rich history, culture, and contributions of Chinese Canadians.

Dr. Sun Yat-Sen Classical Chinese Garden

Built by Chinese artisans using traditional methods, this tranquil garden in Chinatown includes koi ponds, pavilions, tai hu rocks, and 150-year-old bonsai. Guided tours and tea are available.

Graffiti Alley

Vancouver's first legally designated graffiti art wall, donated by the Vancouver Native Housing Society, spans 178 feet behind The Pendera in downtown. Known as Graffiti Alley, it's one of many vibrant spots in Gastown to see colorful murals and street art.

Grouse Mountain

Grouse Mountain is a year-round resort and attraction in North Vancouver offering panoramic views, outdoor adventure, and family-friendly activities for all fitness levels. Ride the iconic Skyride or Blue Grouse Gondola to a stunning alpine setting overlooking Vancouver and the North Shore. At the summit, explore cultural exhibits, visit the resident grizzly bears Grinder and Coola, meet the mountain's owl ambassadors, or relax with a meal on the patio. For more excitement, try the zipline tour, Mountain Ropes Adventure, or the Kids Tree Canopy Adventure.

Heritage Horns at Canada Place

Daily at noon, the Heritage Horns sound the first four notes of O Canada. Originally created in 1967 as a BC Hydro Centennial project, they now mark time on the Canada Place rooftop.

Inuit Gallery of Vancouver

Open daily, the gallery presents museum-quality Inuit and Northwest Coast Indigenous art, including carvings, prints, ceremonial objects, and work by emerging and senior artists.

[MONOVA: Museum of North Vancouver](#)

This interactive museum in Lower Lonsdale shares the stories of Indigenous and settler communities. Highlights include Streetcar 153, Indigenous Welcome Circle, and exhibits on shipbuilding, recreation, and local industry.

[Museum of Anthropology at UBC](#)

Located on ancestral Musqueam land, MOA features over 10,000 objects of First Nations art. Must-sees include the dramatic Great Hall and Bill Reid's The Raven and the First Men. Open year-round with sea-to-sky views.

[Ping Pong Tables under the Cambie Bridge](#)

There are Tiger "Plaza" model ping pong tables under the south side of the Cambie Street Bridge. These Ping Pong Tables are high quality weather-resistant and club-level. This is a great place to play and hang out specially during the rain.

[Prospect Point Lighthouse](#)

A historical lighthouse located in Stanley Park dating back to 1888, though it was replaced with this existing structure in 1948. It is a square cement tower with a focal plane 38 feet above the water. The interior of the structure is not open to the public, but you can walk up to it and just about underneath. There is a night view of the Burrard Inlet and look up at the bridge above.

This 1,000-acre urban oasis features the Seawall (part of the world's longest waterfront path), beaches, totem poles, trails, and the Vancouver Aquarium. Visit the Ted and Mary Greig Rhododendron Garden and the Lighthouse for scenic views.

[Takaya Tours](#)

Join guides from the Coast Salish tribe on a unique and relaxing 2-hour ocean-going canoe adventure beginning in beautiful Deep Cove. Gently paddle a 13-meter, cedar canoe as First Nation guides sing traditional songs, tell stories, and point out ancient village sites. For eternal moments you will touch a world that transcends time.

[Ted and Mary Greig Rhododendron Garden](#)

Established in 1965, this award-winning garden was founded by rhododendron pioneers Ted and Mary Greig.

[The Canadian Trail](#)

Stretching along the west promenade, this walkway is divided into 13 sections representing each province and territory, featuring names of cities and towns in tile and colored glass, ending at the scenic North Point lookout.

[The Polygon Gallery](#)

In North Vancouver's Shipyards District, this donation-based contemporary art gallery focuses on photography and media-based works with dynamic rotating exhibits.

[The Seawall in Vancouver](#)

At just over 13.5 miles, the Stanley Park Seawall in Vancouver is part of the world's longest uninterrupted waterfront path and one of Vancouver's most beloved attractions, offering breathtaking views and space for walking, biking, or skating along the waterfront.

[Vancouver Art Gallery](#)

Founded in 1931, this major museum presents historical and contemporary works from BC, Indigenous artists, and the Asia Pacific. Features include rooftop dining and a gift shop. Admission is free for youth ages 13–18.

[VanDusen Botanical Garden](#)

Spanning 55 acres in the heart of Vancouver, the garden features lakes, 7,500 plant species, a hedge maze, and local wildlife. Guests can dine on-site or picnic among the blooms.

[Voyage Canada Exhibit](#)

Panels along the west promenade share unexpected and heartfelt local stories from across Canada, giving visitors a glimpse into the country's diversity and character.

Kid-Friendly Activities

Chinatown Storytelling Centre

Explore the history of Vancouver's Chinatown through interactive exhibits, artifacts, and personal stories from the 1880s to today. Highlights include the community's role in building Canada and overcoming discrimination.

FlyOver Canada

Experience a thrilling 8-minute flight simulation across Canada at Canada Place. Suspended before a 20-meter screen, riders enjoy motion seating and 4D effects like mist, wind, and scent.

Kids Market on Granville Island

Granville Island's Kids Market features two levels of shops, an arcade, bumper cars, a multi-level play zone, and kid-friendly services.

North Shore Kids Fest

This free festival features live performances, crafts, food trucks, a youth entrepreneur market, and more—all focused on fun and creativity for kids.

Richmond Night Market

Held on weekends and holidays through Oct. 13, the market offers 500+ food vendors, 100+ shops, games, live shows, and a 600-foot zipline ride.

Science World

Hands-on science exhibits, live shows, and rotating feature exhibitions make Science World a top destination for curious minds of all ages.

Stanley Park Water Park

Located in Stanley Park, this free outdoor spray park is open daily through September and is a great way for kids to cool off and play.

Vancouver Aquarium

Home to 65,000+ animals, the aquarium features marine exhibits, a 4D theater, otters and seals, plus dining options with kid-friendly meals.

Vancouver Mysteries

Choose from detective, spy, or superhero-themed games across downtown Vancouver.

Teams follow clues using provided tools—no devices needed. Great for families and groups.

Local Events

Junction Public Market

An open-air artisan market featuring local artists, food vendors, rotating pop-ups, a bar, and live music in repurposed shipping containers.

Shipyards Night Market
